

PROCEDURAL SAFETY CHECKLIST

Before Induction of Anesthesia/ Sedation/Procedure

SIGN IN-INITIATED BY RN

NURSE/ANESTHESIOLOGIST VERIFIES:

1. Patient Identification
 - Matching 2 identifiers with name band
 - Engage parents and patient (when applicable)
2. Procedure/Site/Side
 - Engage parents and patient (when applicable)
3. Site marked by clinician performing procedure
4. Weight and Allergies

Before Skin Incision/Procedure

TIME OUT-INITIATED BY CLINICIAN PERFORMING PROCEDURE

ALL TEAM MEMBERS

1. Introduce self by name and role

CLINICIAN VERIFIES:

2. Patient/Procedure/Site/Side & Position
3. Critical Steps/Anticipated Risks/Duration/EBL
4. Special Equipment/Implants needed
5. Imaging, labs and other relevant preoperative tests reviewed and available

NURSE/ANESTHESIOLOGIST VERIFIES:

6. Antibiotics given within 60min of incision
7. Blood (or cross-match) available
8. Consent matches verbalized procedure
9. Site marking visible in prepped field
10. Special Equipment/Implants available
11. Medications/Solutions labeled on field

Before Patient Leaves Procedure Room

SIGN OUT-INITIATED BY CLINICIAN PERFORMING PROCEDURE

CLINICIAN VERIFIES:

1. Name of procedure to be recorded

TEAM VERIFIES:

2. Final counts
3. Correct labeling of specimens
4. Equipment problems to be addressed
5. Key concerns for post procedure period and plan for safe hand-off
